 - We prefer if the results from the research are open sourced and widely published
 - For one year in the range from \$10K-\$150K
 - Deadlines: February 1st and August 1st of each year
 - ~150 awards every year

- Google Focused Research Award Program
 - For research in areas of study that are of key interest to Google as well as the research community
 - Unrestricted grants are for two to three years
 - Kicked-off on February 2nd 2010
 - 12 awards so far
 - 5.7 M \$ budget
